

Our Merry Way

Choreographer: Don Carleton & Dottie Censabella
Description: 32 count begin/intermediate partner/circle dance
Music: **Let Me Go My Merry Way** by Charlie Rich

Position: open promenade, man's right hand to ladies left
Man's footwork listed, ladies opposite
Intro: 16 counts

Beats / Step Description

STEP, HOLD, STEP, HOLD, STEP, 1/4 TURN & POINT, CROSS, HOLD

1-4 Step right forward, hold, step forward, left, hold
5,6 Step right forward prepping for turn, turn 1/4 turn right (facing partner) pointing left to left side
Pick up ladies right hand in man's left
7,8 Cross left in front of right, hold

ROCK TO SIDE, RECOVER TURNING 1/4 TURN, STEP, HOLD, WALK 3X, POINT

1-4 Rock right to right side, recover to left turn 1/4 turn to left (facing LOD), step forward right, hold
5-8 **Man:** Walk left, right, left, point right to right side (LOD)
Lady: Step forward right, turn 1/4 turn right step left to side, turn 1/4 turn right step right back, point left to left side (RLOD)

Two hand hold

STEP, POINT, STEP, POINT, WALK, WALK, 1/4 TURN, TOUCH

1-4 **Man:** Step right forward, point left to left side, step left forward, point right to right side
Drop man's left, ladies right hands
Lady: Step left back, point right to right side, step right back, point left to left side
5,6 **Man:** Moving to left diagonal cross right in front of left, step left forward
Lady: Turn 1/4 turn left stepping left to left side, turn 1/2 turn left stepping right to right side
Lady turns under man's right arm
7,8 **Man:** Step forward right turning 1/4 turn right (facing partner), touch left next to right (OLOD)
Lady: Cross left in front of right, touch right next to left (ILOD)

STEP, HOLD, STEP, HOLD, SYNCOPATED WEAVE WITH 1/4 TURN

1-4 Step Left to left side, hold, step right behind left, hold
&5&6 Step left slightly back, cross right in front of left, step left to left side, step right behind left
&7,8 Turn 1/4 turn left (LOD) stepping left forward, step forward right (open promenade), step right forward
